The route will take in (not necessarily in the following order):- the Maze, Moorish Tower, Cyprus Pond, Slievenaslat (270 metres), the Annesley Gardens and, of course, Castlewellan Castle and Lake. Overall distance is approx. 16km/10miles and includes a short, steep 270 metre but well-worth-the-effort, climb up to the panoramic viewpoint on Slievenaslat. It should take around 4 hours (with some scope to shorten the walk for those so minded). This is a C Grade walk, but given the distance and the exposed sections on the edge of the forest, it should not be underestimated. Bring refreshments of choice and, as always, have regard to the weather forecast and dress accordingly.
