DATE/ MEET	<p><u>Saturday 18 September 2021</u></p> <p>Meet at Carrick Little Car Park - 9.30am sharp</p>
WALK	<p>On leaving Carrick Little we walk alongside Annalong Wood before turning sharply north west towards Rocky Mountain. On reaching the lower slopes of Rocky we pick up a good path to the North West taking us to Hares Castle.</p> <p>From there we head north along the Annalong Buttress before coming quite quickly onto the Brandy Pad which we follow west.</p> <p>On passing below the Castles at Commedagh we drop down to the Annalong Valley and head south back to Annalong Wood and from there to Carrick Little. This is a C+ walk of 8 miles (13 kilometres) and a total height gained of 450 metres.</p>
