Anglesey Coastal Path 2026
8th to 15th May (subject to confirmation of accommodation)

The Isle of Anglesey Coastal Path is a 210 km (130-mile) long-distance path that follows the coastline of Anglesey and is part of the longer Wales Coastal Path. The path offers diverse landscapes, including wide sandy bays, dramatic cliffs, rocky islets, sand dunes, and forests. The path is way-marked with a blue tern logo and is within an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).

We have approached Anglesey Walking Holidays who confirm that they should be able to facilitate a walking group of 10 to 12. However, for a May 2026 trip we do need to book as soon as possible to secure accommodation. Anglesey Walking Holidays are based on Anglesey and have been operating for over 18 years. They have very good reviews on Trip Advisor.

The intention is to walk half of the Coastal Path (the North Island option – 71 miles). This section goes from Menai to Holyhead and their brochure shows it as taking 7 nights (6 days walking). This can be varied depending on the capabilities of the walking group and the availability of accommodation. They provide luggage transfer as part of the cost.

Anglesey Walking Holidays will confirm the holiday cost as soon as we are able to confirm to make up of our group in terms of accommodation requirements e.g. single, twin or double rooms and travel dates. However, an indicative cost given by their brochure shows a cost for the Northern half (7 nights and 6 days walking) as £885 per person based on two people sharing a room.

The aim would be to take the train to Dublin, then a taxi/ bus to Dublin Port and the Ferry to Holyhead. From Holyhead we should be able to get public transport but if not shared taxis to our accommodation.

As regards dates we have been advised to avoid May bank holiday due to the inevitable pressure on accommodation. This means avoiding Monday 4th May, the preceding weekend and a brief period afterwards. **I am therefore proposing trip dates of 8th to 15th May (subject to confirmation of accommodation).**

We can expect Anglesey Walking Holidays to require at least a £100 non-refundable deposit on booking - with the final balance due 6 weeks before departure. **Please email Colin McWhirter (*****)** as soon as possible if you wish to go on this trip. **If there are still spaces left at that point he will confirm your place. Once our booking is confirmed, deposits will be payable to Anglesey Walking Holidays.**

It would also be helpful to identify who you might be willing share accommodation with or if you require a single room which will, if available, carry a supplement.
